


2020 Parent Code of Conduct



- I will give constructive criticism during a private moment, never in front of other parents, players, officials, spectators, etc.
- I will support my coach and refrain from excessive “sideline coaching” from the stands.
- I will refrain from using profanity.
- I will always show respect for all participants.
- I will place the emotional and physical well-being of my child ahead of a personal desire to win.
- I will abide by a doctor’s decision in all matters of players health and injuries and physical ability to play.
- I will accept the decisions of officials on the field as being fair and called to the best ability of the officials. Parents must stay off the field and remain under control in order to set a good example for players and other spectators.
- I will not criticize an opposing team, its players, fans, coaches or team by words or gestures.
- I will support the coaches, players and officials and help teach the value of commitment to the teams, sportsmanship, ethical conduct and fair play.
- I will not encourage my child or any other person to engage in un-sportsman like conduct with any coach, parent, player, participants, officials or any other attendee.
- I will be responsible for my behavior as well as for the behavior of those who attend the game/practices as my guest.
- I will encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches, and official at every game or practice.
- I will be in control of my emotions.
- I will remain in the spectator area during games/practices.
- I will support coaches and official working with my child, to encourage a positive and enjoyable experience for all.
- I will demand a sports environment for my child that is free of drugs, tobacco, and alcohol and will refrain from their use at all ROPWFA sponsored activities. I will not drink alcohol at a game/practice or come to one having drunk too much.
- I will remember that the game is for our youth – NOT ADULTS – and that participation in youth sports is a privilege, not a right.
- I will do my very best to make youth sports fun for my child. I will not instruct him to harm any other participants.
- I will ask my child to treat other players, coaches, fans, and officials with respect regardless of race, sex, creed or ability.
- I will not make insulting comments to players, parents, officials, or coaches of either team.
- I promise to help my child enjoy the youth sports experience by doing whatever I can, such as being a respectable fan, assisting with coaching, or providing transportation.
- I will require that my child’s coach be trained in the responsibilities of being a youth sport coach and that the coach upholds the Coaches Contract and Code of Conduct.
- I understand that part of practice is to make sure a player is safe when executing plays and tackles. I will have my child at practices and understand that if my child doesn’t attend practices he may not receive playing time based on the league minimum standard.
- I understand that it is important to let my coach or team mom know that my child will not be at practice.
- **I understand that under North West Texas Youth Football Association Bylaws that if I am removed from a game due to my conduct, my Head Coach will also be removed and suspended from the following week of practice and game day.**
- I have read the above Code of Conduct and agree to uphold the agreement. I hereby pledge to provide positive support, care, and encouragement for my child participating in ROPWFA activities by following this Parent’s Code of Conduct. I understand that inappropriate behavior is cause for immediate ejection from games or practices. Repeat offenses will result in being barred from future games and league sponsored activities.
